40 places are available for unemployed or 'under employed' people.

They must:

- o be aged 17 years or over
- o not be enrolled in school
- be unemployed (i.e. not currently employed AND actively looking and available for work)
 VET or university studies do not meet the definition of unemployed.
- <u>OR underemployed</u> (i.e. employed but working 17 hours or less per week and wanting to work additional hours)
- be an Australian OR New Zealand citizen OR a permanent Australian resident OR live in South Australia and have full work rights with no Visa conditions/restrictions
